


Play Cricket Sign Up Process - Joining a Club - Parents, Guardians and Children

Play-Cricket - The Sign Up Process

This document shows the process to sign up to Play Cricket to join any of the Play-Cricket clubs, county board or league sites.

Start by selecting 'Sign Up' at the top of any Play-Cricket site.
